Comment on 'Why choose managed office space?' For Katie Lewis, Fresh Business Thinking From Basepoint Business Centres Ltd

Basepoint Business Centres Ltd operates 26 business centres across the South of England and the Midlands. For businesses, there are many advantages of taking out managed office space such as flexible licensing, business support and networking opportunities.

The Business Portal gives Basepoint tenants the buying power of a major group – from their desktops, licensees can take advantage of the economies of scale savings which are usually only available to large companies.

Other benefits include the use of meeting rooms and facilities at the centres; Lesley Way is the Founder of training company, The Way Ahead, and is based in Basepoint Bournemouth. She says: "We often hold courses or workshops in the meeting rooms in Basepoint, but only have to pay for the space when we are using it. If we had to pay for full time occupancy on such a large room, our overheads would increase significantly."

All Basepoint centres have dedicated reception staff that are always on hand to help out licensees; they assist with day-to-day tasks, welcoming clients and organising networking events – another benefit of managed office space. Stephanie Pettitt, runs accountancy firm Equation Accounting, and is located in Basepoint Weymouth. She comments: "It is great to know that when my clients arrive, someone is there to greet them; it helps to reinforce Equation Accounting's professional image. Basepoint also organise 'coffee and cake mornings' in the centre which are great for networking – as a result of these events, Equation Accounting now deals with a number of other businesses within Basepoint Weymouth."

Basepoint Luton based Sajid Parkar, Founder of Take Two Books, agrees: "It is so convenient to be able to deal with the other businesses within Basepoint; one company from the centre manages the taketwobooks.com website and another is assisting to get the second edition of the book onto iTunes. As long as you are willing to talk about your business, other licensees will always approach you, which is fantastic."

Overall, most companies within Basepoint centres agree that having managed office space has enhanced their business, Lesley concludes: "Having an office in Basepoint has certainly helped TWA to create a professional image; having a business address and a designated space in which to run workshops, together with the lovely Basepoint staff welcoming our clients, has added to our credibility. This in turn, has brought in business."
